We are writing to you to give you an update on where we are in this COVID pandemic. We continue to sincerely hope that you and your family are safe and well. For our staff, there is no higher priority than the health and wellness of our Tepeyac family. As we navigate the quickly changing issue of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, we are heartened to see our families, teachers, staff and community come together—quickly and creatively—to ensure that our students have what they need to continue learning. I wanted to share the wonderful ways our Tepeyac family have come together:

As many of you may have heard, Governor Pritzker has called an end to in-person classes for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. We WILL continue conducting e-learning through June 5, 2020. In addition, please note that we will NOT be giving final exams...2nd semester grades will be calculated based on 3rd and 4th quarter grades.

We will be updating everyone soon on things like cleaning out lockers, Junior Ring Mass, Graduation, and various other logistical issues.

#### **Food Distribution**

We are excited to be distributing hot lunches weekly on Wednesdays, while also supporting a local family restaurant! This is made possible thanks to the **Big Shoulders Fund**. Pick-up is right at the high school (main entrance - blue doors). We will hand your meal-to-go at the door from 11am-1pm.

We will also continue distributing food on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays at the Grade School from 11am-1pm.

# **E-Learning & College Readiness**

Teachers continue to conduct classes through Google Classroom, as well as face-to-face using ZOOM and Google Hangouts. Our gym teacher continues to send students workouts they can do alone or with their families! Teachers are in contact with students via email, ZOOM, Google Classroom and Plus Portal. Seniors have been meeting with Mrs. Dumas-Gray, our College Readiness Director, in terms of planning and making decisions as to their Fall college plans. Advisors have also been checking on their advisees to oversee that our students are updated and progressing with homework assigned to them.
